Re: 10-Million American Inner-City Children Condemned To A “Fate Worse Than Death” And Bank of NY Argues That They Are Not Entitled To “Equal Protection Of The Law” Because That Is Not A “Holocaust”

As you may recall, you have received five letters over the last two years requesting your support regarding lawsuits against 15 major international financial institutions for \$84 billion by –

- Being willing to serve, if the litigation had been successful, on the governing board of an “I Have A Dream”® or IHAD-style foundation that would have provided tutoring and mentoring for 10 million inner-city children from Los Angeles, Oakland and San Francisco as they progressed from kindergarten through high-school graduation and guaranteed their college tuition.
- Contacting the 43 news-media superstars to reinforce the five letters they received from me over the last two years to shine the same spot light on these lawsuits that they routinely shine on, for example, David Boies and his lawsuits such as his Proposition 8 litigation.
- Contacting the 21 governmental officials (including President Obama, Governor Brown, the Mayors of LA, SF & Oakland, California’s U.S. Senators, and the 11 U.S. Representatives that represent LA, SF & Oakland) to reinforce the four letters they received from me over the last two years to request that they ensure that Amicus Curiae (“friend of the court”) briefs would be filed in these lawsuits, at least by the U.S. Justice Department, the State of California, and LA/SF/Oakland, all 5 of which have legal staffs that submit such briefs as a routine matter.
- Praying (together with your congregants) that –
 1. The California judges and U.S. Supreme Court Justices would obey the law; and
 2. The 21 governmental officials and 43 news-media superstars would support the 10 million California inner-city children.

Attached is a 6/22/2011 letter that contains more information and was written to Jonathan Kozol, a famous educator and author who has written nearly a dozen award-winning books on inner-city education starting with “Death At An Early Age” in 1967 through “The Shame of the Nation: The Restoration of Apartheid Schooling in America” in 2005. As stated in the penultimate paragraph of the letter, much more detail is available in the third section of www.ReadingLiberally-SaltLake.org entitled “Possible Topic for Fall 2011.”

I am very sorry to inform you that yesterday the U.S. Supreme Court posted on its website its refusal to hear our final appeal. Accordingly, this is the last report you will receive from me.
